



NEWTON'S CONTRAST GARTER CROPPED VEST HK

YARN: Newton's Yarn Country Wool Silk, knitting two strands

GAUGE: Knitting from two skeins/ends using US 7 to 9 needle
4 sts per inch or 16 sts in 4 inches

SIZE: XS/S (38in) / M/L (42in) / XL (46in)

FINISHED LENGTH: 22 inches



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ABBREVIATIONS:

sts=Stitches

STITCH PATTERN:

Knit stockinette: *Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row*. Repeat from * to *.

BORDER:

1. Using contrast color, cast on 88 sts.
2. Row 1: With contrast color Knit 2 rows,
3. Row 3: With main color, Knit 2 rows.
4. Repeat steps 2 & 3 for a total of 22 rows or 4/4.5/5 inches, ending with contrast color.

GARMENT:

5. You have just completed the front border. Begin garment.
6. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 4/4.5/5 inches. Hang Marker. Begin armhole.
7. At beginning of next row, bind off 36/40/44 sts, purl to end of row.
8. Knit 1 row.
9. Purl 1 row.
10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 for 4/5/6 inches.
11. Using knit cast-on technique, cast on 36/40/44 sts. You should have 72 sts.
12. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 4/4.5/5 inches. Place marker.
13. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 7/7.5/8 inches. Place marker.
14. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 4/4.5/5 inches.
13. At beginning of next row, bind off 36/40/44 sts, purl to end of row.
14. Knit 1 row
15. Purl 1 row
16. Repeat steps 14 and 15 for 4/5/6 inches.
17. Using knit cast-on technique, cast on 36/40/44 sts. You should have 72 sts.
18. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 4/4.5/5 inches. Place marker. Begin border.

BORDER:

19. Add contrast color, knit 2 rows.
20. Change to main yarn, knit 2 rows.
21. Repeat steps 19 to 20 for 22 rows or 4/4.5/5 inches, ending with contrast color.
22. Bind off.



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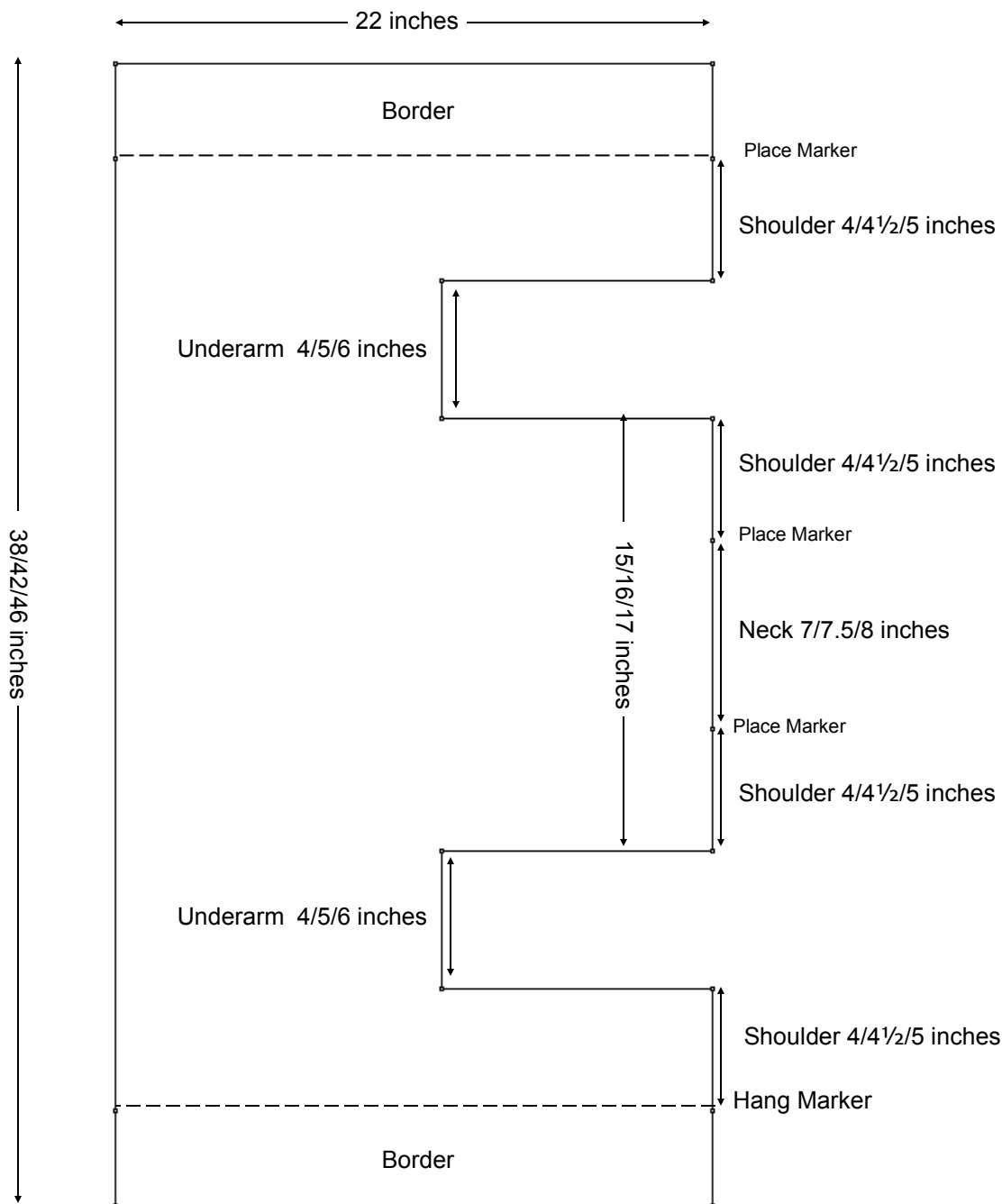
Every effort has been made to have the knitting instructions accurate and complete. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human errors, or typographical mistakes.

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ASSEMBLY:

1. Pick up edge sts along left armhole opening. Knit 1 row, bind off.
2. Now repeat step 1 for right armhole opening.
3. Join shoulder seam from shoulder edge to marker for both left and right shoulder.
4. Pick up edge sts from left border to back neck to right border. Knit 1 row, bind off.
5. On bottom edge, pick up sts. Knit 1 row, bind off.
6. Weave in ends.
7. Block



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
