Newton's Yarn Country "A Tisket, A Tasket" Knitted Clutch or Project Bag

Supplies

- 300 yards Newton's Yarn Country Kroy
- Stash Scraps of hot pink, purple or blue yarns for flowers and green yarn for leaves (yarn that is fat and thin looks best)
- Sizes 8 and 10 needles
- Handles
- Lining
- Needle and thread
- Snap, optional
- Scissors



- 1. With the wool yarn and size 8 needles CO 79 stitches
- 2. Work 10 rows in reverse stockinette stitch
- 3. Work 20 rows in stockinette stitch
- 4. Change to size 10 needles and double the yarn
- 5. Work 40 rows in seed stitch
- 6. Change to size 8 needles and return to a single strand of yarn
- 7. Work 20 rows in stockinette stitch
- 8. Work 10 rows in reverse stockinette stitch

Finishing

- Sew side seams to the top of seed stitch; leave the rest open so the purse can open easily
- Fold reverse stockinette stitch portion over each handle and secure
- Hand sew lining to the top of the seed stitch (or higher if you wish)
- Add decorative flowers and leaves of yarn to both sides
- Secure by knotting or sewing

Flowers

- Make a length of thick/thin yarn in 24-30" and wrap round around your hand
- Tie in the middle and spread/fluff "blossom". Tie with a green piece of yarn to give the appearance of a leaf.
