

Newton's Santa Clara Mitts

Original Design by Mary Ann Archbold
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Supplies

- Monteza Llama Wool Chunky 50/50, 200 yards evenly divided into 2 balls
- Size 9 needles
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers
- Scissors



Directions

- Work both mitts at the same time
- CO 20 (small), 23 (medium) or 26 (large)
- Preparation Row: P

6 Row Pattern:

1. Row 1: K1, *K2, Sl1 wyif*; Repeat from * to *; K1
2. Row 2: P
3. Row 3: K1, *Sl1 wyif*; Repeat from * to *; K3
4. Row 4: P
5. Row 5: *K2, Sl1 wyif*; Repeat from * to *; K2
6. Row 6: P
7. Repeat 6 row pattern 2 more times
8. Work 19 rows in stockinette stitch placing a stitch marker after the 3rd and 19th rows to mark the thumb opening
9. Work 6 row pattern one time
10. Work 1 row in Purl
11. BO loosely
12. Seam the sides of each mitt so that the thumb space is open (between rows 3 and 19 of stockinette stitch)
13. Sew in tails
