Size: One Size

GAUGE: Using size 1-3 needle 7 sts per inch or 28 sts in 4 inches

Newton's Yarn Country Eyelet Neckwarmer Hoodie

Yarn: Pagewood Artesana - 50 grams, 545 yards

Size: One Size

GAUGE: Using size 1-3 needle 7 sts per inch
or 28 sts in 4 inches

ABBREVIATIONS:

sts=Stitches

DIRECTIONS:

- Cast on 120 sts and follow stitch pattern below.

STITCH PATTERN:

Row 1: Knit 1 row.

Row 2: Purl 1 row.

Row 3: Knit 6 sts. *Knit 4, yo, k2 tog; repeat from*; ending with knit 6 sts.

Row 4: Purl 1 row.

Row 5: Knit 1 row

Row 6: Purl 1 row

Row 7: Knit 1 row.

Row 8: Purl 1 row

Row 9: Knit 6 sts. *Knit 2, yo, k2tog, repeat from*; ending with knit 6 sts.

Row 11: Purl 1 row.

Row 12: Knit 1 row.

Row 13: Purl 1 row.

- Repeat row 1 to 13 for 30 inches approximately 195 rows.

BIND OFF METHOD:

1. Knit 6 stitches.
2. Bind off loosely across row until reaching the last 6 stitches.

FINISHING:

1. Unravel the beginning and ending 6 sts on each edge.
2. Seam the bind off sts with cast on edge inside the unraveled sts forming a circle.
3. Weave in ends.
4. Trim unraveled sts to the desired fringe length.

WEARING:

You may fold the neckwarmer in half and wear around your neck or slip the neckwarmer over your head unfolded to wear as a hoodie.
