



NEWTON'S NEVADA/TENCEL LINEN CROPPED VEST

YARN: Newton's Yarn Country NEVADA, 100% Tencel Rayon, 13 oz

GAUGE: Knitting from two skeins/ends using US 7 to 9 needle
4 sts per inch or 16 sts in 4 inches

SIZE: XS/S (38in) / M/L (42in) / XL (46in)

FINISHED LENGTH: 22 inches

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ABBREVIATIONS:

sts=Stitches

STITCH PATTERN:

Knit stockinette: With 2 strands of yarn held together; *Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row*. Repeat from * to *.

BORDER:

1. Begin at front, with 2 strands of contrast color held together, cast on 72 sts.
2. Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row.
3. With 2 strands main color held together, Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row.
4. Knit 24 sts. Turn, you are now on the purl side, slip the next stitch purlwise, purl to end of row.
5. Knit 23 sts. Turn, you are now on the purl side, slip the next stitch purlwise, purl to end of row.
6. Knit 21 sts. Turn, you are now on the purl side, slip the next stitch purlwise, purl to end of row.
7. Knit 18 sts. Turn, you are now on the purl side, slip the next stitch purlwise, purl to end of row.
8. Knit 14 sts. Turn, you are now on the purl side, slip the next stitch purlwise, purl to end of row.
9. Using contrast color knit 1 row, purl 1 row.
10. With main yarn, knit 1 row.
11. Purl 48 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 24 sts.
12. Purl 25 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 24 sts.
13. Purl 26 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 24 sts.
14. Purl 27 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 24 sts.
15. Purl 24 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 58 sts.
16. Purl 72 sts
17. With contrast color, Knit 1 row, purl 1 row.
18. Using main color knit 72 sts
19. Purl 24 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 24 sts.
20. Purl 25 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 25 sts.
21. Purl 27 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 27 sts.
22. Purl 30 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 30 sts.
23. Purl 34 sts. Turn, you are now on the knit side, slip the next stitch, knit 34 sts.
24. Purl 72 sts
25. Using contrast color, Knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

GARMENT:

28. You have just completed the front border. Begin garment.
29. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 26/28/30 rows. Hang Marker.
30. At beginning of next row, bind off 36/40/44 sts, purl to end of row.
31. Knit 36/32/28 sts.
32. Purl 36/32/28 sts.
33. Repeat steps 30 and 31 for 24/30/36 rows.
34. Using knit cast-on technique, cast on 36/40/44 sts. You should have 72 sts.
35. Purl 72 sts.
36. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 26/28/30 rows. Place marker.
37. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 42 rows. Place marker.
38. Continue knitting in stitch pattern for 26/28/30 rows.

BORDER:

39. Repeat steps 17 to 24.
40. Repeat steps 9 to 16.
41. Repeat steps 2 to 9.
42. Bind off.



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
Every effort has been made to have the knitting instructions accurate and complete. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human errors, or typographical mistakes.

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ASSEMBLY:

1. Pick up sts along armhole edge. Knit 1 row, bind off.
2. Join shoulder seam from shoulder edge to marker.
3. Along neck edge, pick up sts. Knit 1 row, bind off.
4. On bottom edge, pick up sts. Knit 1 row, bind off.
5. Weave in ends.



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
